50-year-old Win Whittaker is an avid mountaineer and climbing instructor from Washington State, based just outside of Mount Rainier National Park. Born into a famous mountaineering family, Win's uncle, Jim Whittaker, was the first American to summit Mount Everest. His father, Lou Whittaker, is also a lifelong mountain climber – so it's no surprise that Win's first time summiting Mount Rainier was at the age of 12. Since then, he has summited Rainier more than 180 times.

Win's hearing loss was gradual, and the result of a number of factors, including his love for music and playing in a band, an affinity for fireworks, and a thirst for adventure. Both he and his wife Sarah noticed the gradual changes, and when Win realized the impact of his hearing loss on his daily life – from leading groups on Mount Rainier to his regular social interactions – he knew it was time to take action.
